n this Easter season we take courage in the words of the Apostles' Creed: "I believe in the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting."

Our connection Christ's death and resurrection is made clear in Romans 6:4-5: "We were buried therefore with Him by Baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with Him in a death like His, we shall certainly be united with Him in a resurrection like His." Now we anticipate the day of Christ's return when our bodies shall be raised in glory to live in His joyful presence forever. Focusing on our part with Christ's resurrection gives us confidence as we live and serve in this challenging world and time.

Easter's significance changes our whole reality. "Death has been swallowed up in victory...thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Corinthians 15:54, 57). Our confidence while through this world's chaos is elevated by Christ's assertion, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in Me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die" (John 11:25-

The faith of ancient believers also inspires confidence in us. As an example, Job, who suffered the loss of his possessions and health, boldly looked forward to the resurrection of his body fully restored. "For I know that my Redeemer lives, and at the last He will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God. whom I shall see for myself, and my eyes shall behold, and not another. My heart faints within me!" (Job 19:25-27). By faith we, like Job, know that death cannot tear us away from our joyful future in glory with our resurrected Christ. God's Word gives us a guarantee: "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things?"(Romans 8: 31-32) Thus with certitude we confess: "On the Last Day He will raise me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true" (Luther's Small Catechism).

May this Easter assurance inspire our celebration and confession of the ancient saying:

"Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!"

Vacation Bible School "Celebrate the Savior, Jesus Gives Us Joy"

"Wow! I remember the VBS when I made this", I said while picking up the cork rectangular wall hanging stuffed inside my 'hope chest'. It had purple crushed marbles glued together to form a grape cluster topped with a plastic leaf. On a paper pasted at the bottom was written "I am the vine, ye are the branches... John 15:5."

You probably have a similar memory of Vacation Bible School as a child. You may also think of some great times as a leader or helper in summertime VBS. The questions children asked and the encouragement you offered may also resonate with you.

This year June 17-21, from 8:45am through noon, Trinity Lutheran Church will welcome boys and girls 5 years through 5th grade to VBS. There is really no age limit on the upper end as teens and adults are encouraged to invite kids and to attend to lead and help children "Celebrate the Savior". We will celebrate that "Jesus Gives Us Joy" learning about: Wisemen Worship Jesus; Jesus Heals a Man Lowered through a Roof; Jesus Feeds Five Thousand; Jesus Died and Rises Again; and Jesus on the Road to Emmaus. We will learn through singing and puppet shows with a carnival atmosphere, Bible storytelling and science experiments, games and crafts and of course, snacks. We will focus on learning scripture verses to apply what we have learned to our hearts.
