

TLC Movie Night "Family Camp" Sunday, Sept 18 @ 6:00pm



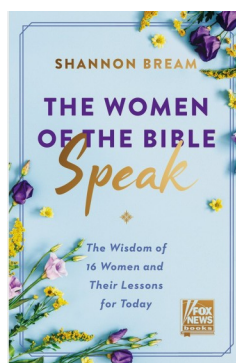

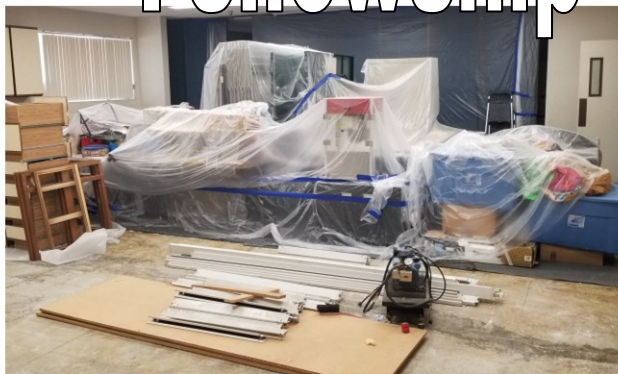

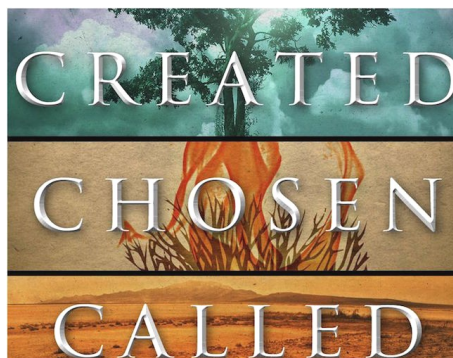

Sunday School “God Calls a Nation”
