## No God, No Peace Know God, Know Peace

aybe you've seen that refrain on a bumper sticker or elsewhere. I don't know who came up with it, but it captures a powerful truth.

Without God in our lives - not knowing Him - we remain without peace. What's worse, according to the Bible, we remain condemned by His law as a result of our disobedience to Him. Romans 6:23a explains, "The wages of sin is death..." That thought certainly gives no peace to anyone without trust in God. To put a fine point on all this, Hebrews 9:27 reveals what happens when one dies, "It is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment." Without God's approval, we would only be destined to the horror of never having peace under God's judgment in an eternal hell.

However, good news shines forth in the second part of the refrain: "Know God-Know Peace." Romans 6:23b reveals God's loving plan for

those who know (trust in) Him. "The free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Christ bought that gift for everyone with His own life given in His crucifixion. By His powerful resurrection from the dead, He proved His victory over our sin and death and shows us His peace that passes all understanding. All who know (trust in) Him have that peace.

Romans 5:1-2 reveals the extent of God's peace to us through Jesus Christ. "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through Him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God."

To know (trust in) God and His salvation through the death and resurrection of Jesus is to know eternal peace.





## The Suffering Servant

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

This is probably the most well known Bible verse. I do not watch sporting events anymore, so I do not know if it still happens, but in the past, there was usually a poster somewhere in the stadium with John 3:16 on it and the TV camera usually showed it several times. So, everyone knows the words, but do they-we-know what the verse actually means?

Four vignettes in Isaiah show us the Messiah in the Servant Songs. In Isaiah 42:1-7 we meet an unassuming person called the Servant of the Lord. God has endowed him with His Spirit. This servant will work quietly, bringing justice to the nations. He will work until he has accomplished his purpose.

Isaiah 49:16 the Servant notes that the Lord called him from his mother's womb, making his mouth like a sharp sword. I will make you a light for the nation, that my salvation may reach the end of the earth. Isaiah 49:6b

Jewish theologians assumed that the Servant was a prophet, maybe Jeremiah; or possibly a king. Since suffering and death weren't what the Jews wanted in a Messiah, they couldn't accept that Isaiah was writing about the Savior they were looking for.

Since the beginning of the Christian era, theologians have recognized that Isaiah is writing about the Messiah. The Ethiopian eunuch in Acts is reading Isaiah and asks Philip who is Isaiah writing about. Philip immediately identified Jesus as the Servant -Messiah.

In Isaiah 50:4-9 the Servant says that he wakens each day so that he can listen to God. He does not turn back from his task; he will not be deterred even when he suffers abuse.

Finally, in the fourth vignette, we get to the nitty-gritty of the Messianic message. The first three Servant Songs tell us of the responsibilities of the Messiah. Isaiah 52:13—53:12 describes the Suffering Servant. We have heard many of the verses in Lenten messages and readings over the years.

He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth; like a lamb He was led to the slaughter,...He bore the sins of many and makes intercession for the transgressors. Isaiah 53:7, 12b

Thus, we understand John 3:16. God sent Jesus to be a sacrifice for our sins. Jesus work before his Crucifixion defined the lives we are to lead while we wait to join Jesus in heaven, but, everything was leading to the cross and ultimately the Resurrection. Praise God!


